### Tournament Conditions

1. This is a WA Squash approved Tournament.
2. The Tournament will be played under WSF Rules.
3. Clothing as provided for in the WA Squash Regulations is to be worn.
4. Players will not be permitted to play until their entry fee is paid.
5. All men's, women's and junior's events shall consist of the best of five games and games shall be played using the PAR system.
6. Grades entered must be the highest pennant grade being played at the time of the Tournament. When the Tournament occurs between pennant seasons, the grade is determined according to the grade played in the last pennant season. It is the players' responsibility to enter the correct grade and prize money may be forfeited if players are found to have entered the incorrect grade.
7. Request for exemptions must be advised on the entry forms. If requests cannot be accommodated, players will be advised prior to the draw.
8. The Tournament Organisers, WA Squash and its officers, employees or agents shall not be liable for any death or personal injury or loss or damages to property sustained or incurred by any person in connection with the Tournament howsoever caused.
9. All juniors are required to wear protective eyewear.
10. Players may enter one event only, with the exception of juniors who may enter two, proof of age may be required.
11. The Tournament committee reserve the right to re-grade any player or not accept a player's entry prior to commencement of the Tournament.
12. If there are not enough numbers for the draw, the Tournament Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate one grade into another or cancel that grade.
13. Forfeits count as matches.
14. Players are responsible for verifying playing times by telephoning the Tournament Director re the draw on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2010.
15. Dunlop balls as per WA Squash metropolitan pennant competition will be used.
